

WACF ENDOWMENT FUNDS

Fund A: Wawasee Area Conservancy Foundation Endowment Fund

This is a permanent fund. No invasion of the corpus gift is permitted. Only a portion of the growth income will be available for annual distribution to Fund B.

Fund B: Wawasee Area Conservancy Foundation Fund

This is a nonpermanent fund. It is intended to serve as a depository for a portion of the income from the permanent fund (Fund A) and as an investment for monies given to WACF where it was not the intent of the donor to retain the funds permanently. The full amount of the fund, or parts thereof, can be distributed to and used by WACF subject to approval by 2/3rds of the voting members of the Board of Directors of WACF.
